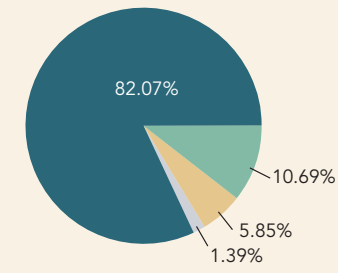

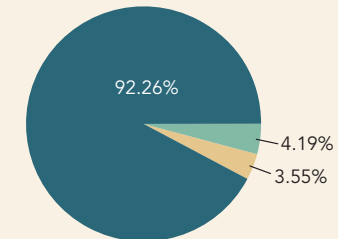
FISCAL YEAR 2009 REVENUE, SUPPORT, AND EXPENSES

OUTPATIENT SERVICES

Providing specialized hospice care promoting comfort and quality of life for patients where they are living; in their own home, in assisted living or a nursing facility.

HOSPICE HOME

Admission to the Hinds Hospice Home can occur when a patient requires a higher level of care than can be provided in their own home environment.

PEDIATRIC PROGRAM – "THE GIFT OF HOME"

When a child has a life-limiting illness or condition, it takes a team of specially trained professionals to ensure that symptoms are managed and the family is supported. Trained pediatric social workers, nurses, home health aides, chaplains and volunteers are available to help families.

Hinds Hospice works closely with Children's Hospital of Central California, UC San Francisco and Lucile Packard Children's Hospital at Stanford.

"It may not make any sense, but the most vivid, happy memories of our daughter were given to us at the Hinds Hospice Home. It was the first time that we were able to be a family and fulfill some of the visions of Mia's life



that we had dreamed. Mia's big sister got to meet, hold and kiss her for the first time. We decorated her room as a nursery and brought in stuffed animals and all the little outfits

that we couldn't bring into the hospital. We could sit on a bed with our baby, rock in a chair, and even doing things as simple as closing a door and being alone to take a nap along side our precious baby."
