- Carries out social evaluations and plans intervention based on evaluation findings. Counsel's patient and family/caregiver(s) as needed in relationship to stress, and other identified coping difficulties.
- Maintains clinical records on all patients referred to social work.
- Provides information and referral services for organization patients and families/caregivers regarding practical and environmental needs.
- Provides information to patients, their families/caregivers, and community agencies.
