Angels of Grace: Angels of Grace provides resources to and advocates on behalf of foster children in need. The team works tirelessly to create an environment of growth and stability that will enhance the lives of the children they serve, many of whom have experienced abuse or neglect.

Art of Life Cancer Foundation: The Art of Life Cancer Foundation empowers individuals and families to discover the art of living through healing arts opportunities and workshops that celebrate life and inspire hope.

Breaking the Chains: Breaking the Chains is a human trafficking non-profit organization located in California's Central San Joaquin Valley. They work with local, state, and federal law enforcement agencies to provide rescue, relocation, restorative, and residential services to adult female victims of human trafficking.

CASA of Fresno and Madera Counties: CASA of Fresno and Madera Counties is a voice for abused and neglected children in our community who have been placed in foster care.

Central California Food Bank: Currently serving 350,000 people each month (116,000 of which are children) and partnering with more than 220 local organizations including school districts, college campuses, hot meal sites, appointment-based programs and more, Central California Food Bank can help provide up to 7 meals with just \$1.00.

Foundation for Sanger Schools: The Foundation for Sanger Schools supports the students, teachers, and families of Sanger Unified School District by funding innovative educational programs and student scholarships designed to enhance the culture of educational excellence throughout the District.

Fresno Mission: Fresno Mission rescues, restores, and empowers those struggling with homelessness, addiction, hunger, poverty, abuse, trafficking, trauma, and other life-insecurities through Christ-centered communities of transformation.

Fresno Police Chaplaincy: Project STEALTH (Stop Teen Exploitation and Liberate Through Hope) is an incredible social justice outreach bringing hope into the lives of at-risk youth in Fresno through education, intervention, and mentorship.
