## **12-week HALO Support Group begins Tuesday, February 4, 2025**

HALO (Healing after a loss by overdose), is a support program offered by the Center for Grief and Healing at Hinds Hospice. We know that losing a loved one to a drug-related death impacts a family deeply and the feelings of isolation that grievers can experience.

The HALO program is currently offering a parent-specific support group on Tuesday evenings. Our goal is to create a safe and supportive environment where parents can experience their grief and connect with other parents who have experienced a similar loss. We also have grief support groups for children and teens.

**Closed HALO Group (for parents only), space is limited and advanced registration is required.**

The next session will begin Tuesday, February 4, and will be held Tuesday night for 12 weeks from 6:30—7:30 p.m.

**Open HALO Group, no advanced registration needed, and no fee to attend.**

Drop-in sessions are open to anyone impacted by a drug overdose loss and will be available one time a month on the 2nd Thursday of the month from 6:30—8 p.m.
